MP Fadi Abboud: "This boat show endorses Beirut's significance on the international scene and reaffirms trust in the capital's potential."

Beirut, May 17, 2012: Representing H.E. the President of the Lebanese Republic, General Michel Sleiman, the Prime Minister and the Speaker of the House, the Minister of Tourism, Mr. Fadi Abboud, launched the Eighth Edition of the International Boat and Super Yacht Show, **Beirut Boat 2012**, at La Marina Joseph Khoury, Dbayeh.
